Re: Title IX Compliance

Dear Acting Assistant Secretary Trainor,

On behalf of the **[School District Name]** School Board, I write to inform you of our intent to continue to comply with Title IX of the Education Amendments of 1972. Our Board found it necessary to communicate this to you in light of the ongoing dispute between your office and the Maine Department of Education regarding recent executive orders issued by President Trump. Given the national controversy surrounding Maine, our governor, and our Department of Education's stated intention to defy the President's orders, we want to assure you that we will fully comply with federal law.

To the extent that Maine law conflicts with Title IX, we understand that our first obligation under the United States Constitution is to follow federal law. We intend to do so. We only ask that your office support us in this decision should Maine State authorities attempt to coerce our District into violating federal law.

We appreciate your advocacy for the rights of women and girls in our state and across the country.
